Internship Placements

MPA students who do not have at least one year of professional level experience in the public sector or in a nonprofit agency are required to complete GVPA 693: Public Administration Practicum (3 credit hours). The public service internship provides the student with work experience and a realistic exposure to an organizational-bureaucratic environment. This experience should develop the student's awareness of the internal dynamics of an organization and of the value and attitudes of public employees to both their clientele and their administrative-political superiors.


